Definitions

The following defined terms apply:

“Documents” means the LSSA’s suite of property documents including any associated instructions and other materials;

“Licence Type” means the type of licence for which you have paid applicable fees to LSSA. Each Licence Type has defined rights to use one, some or all of the Documents (and associated limitations and restrictions on use) as specified by LSSA;

“LSSA” means the Law Society of South Australia and its officers, employees and agents;

“Subscription Period” means a period commencing on the date on which you accept these terms and conditions and pay LSSA the fees applicable to your selected Licence Type and expiring at the end of the current financial year;

“you” or **“your”** means any person who uses or attempts to access or use any of the Documents and includes (where permitted by your Licence Type) any other persons you cause or permit to access and use the Documents; and

“use” means any access to, downloading, copying, modification and other use of any part of any of the Documents.

Application of terms and conditions: These terms and conditions govern any use or attempted use of any of the Documents. You must not use or attempt to use any of the Documents unless you have read and accepted these terms and conditions. By downloading or attempting to download the Documents or by using or attempting to use any of the Documents, you will thereby confirm your acceptance and agreement to be bound by these terms.

Licence Type: Your rights to use the Documents are limited to the Licence Type for which you have paid applicable fees. You must not cause or permit any use or attempted use of the Documents by anyone or for any purpose not permitted by your Licence Type. Your Licence Type may be limited to one or only a subset of the Documents, in which case you must only use or attempt to use the Documents covered by your Licence Type. If your Licence Type permits use by persons other than you (for example, your Licence Type may permit use by any member of your law firm) then (a) you must be authorised by each of those persons to accept these terms and conditions on their behalf; and (b) you must ensure that each person complies with these terms and conditions.

Duration of licence: Regardless of the Licence Type, you may only use the documents during the Subscription Period. You may be able to renew the Subscription Period for a further term by payment of a further fee and you should consider the availability of a renewal before the expiration of the current Subscription Period.

You acknowledge that the Documents are only a useful guide and starting point for the preparation of a final version of the relevant type of document. Document formats and security: The Documents may be made available in one or more formats. You should ensure that the formats are suitable for your purposes. LSSA may change the formats of Documents from time to time. Some Documents may be provided in a protected form which prevents or limits the modification of the Document. You must not avoid or attempt to circumvent that protection or modify protected parts of a Document.

Amendment of Document and of these Terms: LSSA may change or remove any of the Documents and any of these terms and conditions from time to time. You should therefore check these terms and conditions every time before you download the Documents and you should only proceed to access and use the Documents if you accept the amendments.

Copyright: LSSA owns and retains the copyright and other intellectual property rights in the Documents. You must ensure that any copyright notices included in the Documents are retained. Subject to the rights granted for your Licence Type, you must not use, download, upload, copy, print, display, perform, reproduce, publish, license, post, transmit or distribute any of the Documents in whole or in part without LSSA’s prior written permission. You must take all reasonable measures to ensure that unauthorised access to, use and copying of the Documents cannot occur.

Warranties: LSSA does not attempt to exclude any conditions, warranties, rights or remedies which you may have pursuant to legislation to the extent that those rights and remedies cannot be excluded by agreement (“non-excludable rights”). LSSA warrants that, to the best of its knowledge, your use of the relevant Documents in accordance with your Licence Type and the other provisions of these terms and conditions will not infringe the intellectual property rights of any third party. Subject to this warranty and any non-excludable rights, all express or implied conditions or warranties or representations of any kind are excluded.

Liability: Subject to any non-excludable rights, your use of the Documents is entirely at your own risk. In no event will LSSA be liable for any damages whatsoever (including, without limitation, direct, indirect, punitive, special or consequential damages, lost profits, lost data or business interruption) arising out of the use, inability to use, or the results of use of the Documents, whether based on contract, tort, statute, common law, equity or any other legal theory and whether or not LSSA has been advised of the possibility of such damages. If circumstance arise where you are entitled to claim damages from LSSA notwithstanding this provision (for example, pursuant to any non-excludable rights), LSSA’s liability to you for the aggregate of such claims (regardless of the basis on which you are entitled to claim from LSSA) is limited to the provision of the Documents again or payment of the cost of providing the Documents again (at LSSA’s election).

Indemnification: You must indemnify LSSA and keep LSSA indemnified against all claims, liabilities, expenses (including legal fees on a solicitor-client basis) or losses that may be made against or sustained by LSSA arising from your breach of these terms and conditions or otherwise howsoever from or in connection with your use of the Documents.

Termination: You may terminate the licence to use the Documents at any time and without cause by giving LSSA written notice of termination. If you breach any of these terms and conditions, then (without limiting LSSA’s other remedies) LSSA may immediately suspend your access to the Documents. If you fail to remedy a breach of these terms and conditions within 14 days after LSSA notifies you of the breach, then LSSA may terminate this agreement. If termination occurs, this shall not limit any liability to pay any fees to LSSA which are due at the time of termination. The provisions of these terms and conditions relating to Copyright, Warranties, Liability, Indemnification and Termination shall survive the termination and continue to apply
